SPECIAL PUPPY (Ent 2, abs 1)

1. Vockings Portunes Revolution – Orange Roan 9mths, nicely matured with a masculine head, soft expression and dark eye, well placed shoulders, moved well with powerful rear action and happy despite standing alone.

SPECIAL NOVICE (Ent 2, abs 0)

1. Thomas' Claramand Cozmic – Orange Roan just 13mths presented a neat square, attractive head with correct shoulder placement and good depth of body, short coupled with neat feet, moved out soundly.
2. Baker's Stobytil We're Gonna Rock – Dark blue rising 2 slow to mature, attractive masculine head with a dark eye, extremely well presented tends to carry tail a little high when on the move.

1. Williams & Robinson's Wilmerella Perfect Storm – Blue dog, beautifully presented, strong head with dark eyes, good depth of body and well ribbed, short and cobby with good angulation front and back. Moved out soundly

SPECIAL GRADUATE (Ent 4, abs 0)

1. Mason's Sandlauga Soul Man -Gold dog my critique starts with the word bouncy, needs to settle. Excellent bone and structure with correct angulation, good depth of body straight front, square frame nothing exaggerated.
2. Stack's Izzenberr Ore Asset – Gold dog, slightly longer cast than 1, excellent depth of body with well sprung ribs, moved out well.

SPECIAL GRADUATE (Ent 3, abs 1)

1. Rahman & Williams' Sensqui Blackout – Black dog, definition of square and cobby. Good reach of neck on well laid shoulders, straight front and good depth of body neat feet. Well-presented and moved out with purpose and held a level topline, shortlisted for the CC.
2. Grist's Kasordon Firestarter – another quality black, Square frame, masculine head with dark eye, good depth of body with correct rear angulation. Moved out soundly.

Balanced head laid back shoulders well sprung ribs, short backed with excellent angulation front and back. Moved out soundly with level topline.
