

## Open Show April 2003

### Judge: Nanette Howell

Thank you very much to the officers and committee for inviting me to judge at this show and exhibitors for their quality entry. Main results were BIS Helenwood Amere. RBIS Sheigra Swinging Sixties. BP Fendrove I'm No Angel at Claramand. BOS Chavez Royal Purser. BMP Delindere Girl Friday.

RED, GOLD, LIVER, LIVER/TAN: P (5). 1 Thomas's Fendrove I'm No Angel at Claramand. Red B. Attractive feminine head and eye expression, good fore face, angulation both ends gd, not overdone, clean shoulders and flow through to firm top line, making a v attractive well balanced little girl, lovely coat; 2 Palmer's Robraine Tendulkar. Red D. Younger less mature D, good front, legs and feet, pleasant head not overdone, not co-operating with handler thus not moving behind as well as he could.

J (4). 1 Brough's Welson Montoya. Red D. Masculine head, good bone and feet, just moves a little close behind.

G (5). 1 Marris-Bray's Helenwood Technique. Red D. Well boned, lovely front assembly, good head and eye expression, moved well, v happy Cocker; 2 Ward's Wensom I'm Your Man. Golden D. Quite an attractive D not as masculine as I would like, moves well, needs to mature; 3 Gilmour's Chavez First Choice. Red B.

O (4). 1 West's Sheigra Swinging Sixties. Red B. Well angulated both ends short coupled, neat feet, well off in substance, v pleasant eye and expression, moved with motivation and happiness; 2 Pudney's Othamcourt Sunkist at Cascadia. Red B. Close up to first, sweetest head and eye expression, not quite the angulation of first but v attractive B both in looks and movement, shown in super condition; 3 Gifford's Indumiso Shauney.

Red D. BLACK, BLACK/TAN: P (9). 1 Marris-Bray's Helenwood Forest Glade. Black B. Lovely balanced, short coupled B with super bone, lovely dark eyes with soft expression. Best shoulders in class. Moved in true Cocker style as conformation promised; 2 Thomas' Claramand Looking Good. Black B. Not so forward as first, bit good proportionally and moved well; 3 Moulton-Wynne's Stromboli Sweet Savannah.

Black B. J (9). 1 Palmer's Robraine Davendra JW. Well bodied strong D. Nicely worked head, good bone and feet. Moved ok, Well put down; 2 Duddelk and Mansell's Charbonnel Yvette. Attractive B good turn of stifle, could have a bit more bone, carrying too much weight on the day; 3 Ward's Wensum Mardi Gras.

Black/tan B. G (4). 1 Ward's Wensum Mardi Gras. Black/tan B. Attractive good headed B, nicely marked, good neck and shoulders flowing through well to top line, well angulated, moving freely, good chest; 2 Parker's Weyhill Gabrielle. Black B. Substantial B well made throughout good neck and shoulders just a little nervous on the move.

O (4). 1 Gifford's Indumiso Tears. Black B. Well bodied, good angulation both ends, kind eye, nervous on the move.

ANY SOLID COLOUR: MPD (7). 1 Thomas' Claramand Hells Angel. Black D. V nice well bodied, D, good angulation both ends, good bone and feet, good head and kind eye; 2 Gilmour's Chavez Royal Cavalier. Red D. Younger D so not as mature as 1 though of different type; 3 Gifford's Indumiso Resolution.

MPB (8). 1 Reed's Delindre Girl Friday. Black B. Compact, well bodied baby with good chest, v pretty head and eye expression, lovely little neat feet, so well balanced throughout, oozing confidence for age, especially in ring presence, hope she fulfills her promise as she matures; 2 Rowland's Perrytree Dolly Daydream. Red. More grown than first, v well balanced and nicely made throughout. Had a good forechest and lovely eye expression. Was a bit hesitant in movement; 3 Roes' Roessque So Classy. Black.

PD (7). 1 Walker's Cardamine Bring Me Sunshine. Red. good head and eye, neck shoulder flow through to top line lovely. Well angulated with strength both ends. Well balanced compact D. V happy on the move really enjoying himself, tail never stopped; 2 Thomas' Claramand Hells Angel; 3 Marris-Bray's Lujesa Instigator at Helenwood.

PB (5). 1 Marris-Bray's Helenwood Forest Glade; 2 Walker's Cardamine Bring Me Love. V like winning brother in previous class. Not quite so outgoing but a v nicely made B; 3 Moulton-Wynnes' Stromboli Sweet Seraphina.

J (8). 1 Lumley's Jimmison Jinseng. Black B. Well balanced square B, nice shoulders and chest, good head and eye, neat feet, a little nervous at first but then found her confidence and moved well; 2 Ward's Wensum Jane Eyre. Black B. Bigger than first but nicely made, not as well angulated as winner but a happy balanced little girl; 3 Harris' Melgrove Fatal Attraction.

M (7). 1 Ward's Wensum Jenson Button. Black D. Balanced, compact, well ribbed D, kind eye and expression, some reluctance in moving but when he listened to his handler he moved well, in good coat and condition; 2 Duddell and Mansell's Charbonnel Yvette; 3 Gladman's Chativore Ashleys Mistletoe.

N (9). 1 Thomas; Fendrove I'm No Angel at Claramand; 2 Ward's Wensum Jenson Button; 3 Charbonnel Yvette.

G (9). 1 Ward's Wensum Jane Eyre; 2 Walker's Cardamine Libra. Red B. Lovely balanced well angulated B with super bone and good tail set. Feminine head with nice square muzzle; 3 West's Sheigra Solar Symphony. Red B.

PG (7). 1 Marris-Bray's Helenwood Irresistabelle. Black B. Lovely square compact B, enough angulation both ends. Pleasant head and eye expression. Strong back, good bone and feet; 2 Rowland'' Perrytree Golden Plum. Red B. Close between these two, lovely head and eye, good fore chest, not quite as much angulation as shoulder as first. Pity they met; 3 Harris' Cardamine King Edward.

OD (7). 1 Gilmour's Chavez Royal Purser. Black. V nice square D, good shoulder, super bone, well set tail, good feet, pleasant masculine head; 2 Costellos Judika Prairie Gold. Golden. Not as good in shoulder or upper arm which showed in his front movement was much better. good masculine head, well coated; 3 Walker's Cardamine Hot Potato.

OB (5). 1 Marris-Bray's Helenwood Amere. Black. V good balanced, well made B, gentle eye expression, correct neck, good top line, kept on the move, lovely well boned legs and good front, well coated, super B; 2 Gifford's Idumiso Tears. Black.  
V 1 Pudsey's Cascadia Caution To The Wind. Golden B. Showing age just a little in head colouring but bodily coat lovely, moving v well and happily obviously still enjoying her showing. A pleasure to judge; 2 Bowman's Asquannes Gopenge. Black D. Well made D keeping his colour well ,gd bone enough angulation, covering the ground well, proud tail spoiled his overall picture, both these Veterans were a credit to their owners.
