As a founder member and former committee member of this Association I was delighted to be invited to judge the bitch entry at this first Championship Show. It is a few years since I last judged the breed and I found the general quality and presentation of exhibits to be of a higher standard than hitherto. The officers and committee are to be congratulated for the successful organisation of this show. Everything ran like clockwork.

- SpR/G/LIVER P. (3). 1. Siviter's, Lochranza Specially Made for Trentshome. Feminine red shown in lovely coat and bloom. Pretty head and tight dark eye. Good coat and sound mover. G. (2). 1. Seaman's, Fendrove Anne Oakley. Pleasing red in full coat. Good head, soft expression. Good shoulders. Moved with drive.
- O. (3). Close decision between first and second. 2. Share-Jones's, Sharemead Saffron. 5 years old with beautiful head and expression. Tight cat like feet. Well presented. Excellent flat coat. Good mover. 2. Needham's, Claramand B-Having at Merryhaze. This 6 years old has a pretty head. Good neck and shoulders but not quite the drive of winner on the day. 3. Pearce's, Miska Walking on Sunshine.
- SpBLACK/B/T /SABLE P. (5). 1. Thomas's, Claramand Black Ice. Smart 11 months old black with straight sleek coat but plenty of feather. Pleasing outline. Good mover. 2. Marris-Bray's, Helenwood Dazzlyn. Compact 9 months old black. Pretty head and expression. Good neck and shoulders. Moved with drive. Not as mature as winner. 3. Warington's, Zakova Joules.
- G. (7). 1. Lester's, Quettadene Seeing Stars. This impressive bitch was shown in gleaming coat and condition. She presents a most pleasing outline both when standing and on the move. 2. Pudney's, Cascadia Cin n Gin. Black so typical of this kennel. Feminine head and melting expression. Sound merry mover. 3. Boulton's, Claramand Chrystal Gaze over Christoil.
- OB. (2). 1. Gillespie and Wilding's, Lochranza Posh Socks at Jayzander. Smart b/t of good make and shape. Presenting a pleasing outline. Excellent coat. Good quarters. Stylish mover. 2. Turner's, Maljona Mistress Madrigal at Jalankiu. Different type from winner. Compact with feminine head. Neither the finish nor movement of winner.
- AOC PB. (7). 1. Murray's, Castanea O' So Blue. Attractive blue of 11 months. She has a most pleasing outline. Sweetest of heads and expression. Sound mover. 2. Gilmour's, Chavez Razzamatazz. 10 months old blue in full coat. Another pleasing head. Tight cat feet. Well muscled quarters. Not as compact as winner. 3. Wilding's, Jayzander Strands of Gold. GB. (8). Little to separate first and second. 1. Read's, Jardinisle Class Act. Dark blue typical of this kennel. Well proportioned. Sweet head, melting expression. In good coat, tight feet. Sound mover. 2. Grice's, Kyna Looby Lou. Another feminine bitch of pleasing proportions. Sound bustling movement. 3. Palmer's, Ellgars Bitconfused at Robraine.
- AC VB (8). 1. Pudney's, Sh Ch. Othamcourt Sunkist at Cascadia JW. Elegant 7 year old golden in excellent coat and gleaming condition. One of the best heads of the day. Good legs and feet. Sound positive mover. A credit to her owner. 2. Reeds's, Reemif from Bramble Thorns. 9 years old o/r of good type. Pretty head, dark eye. Short cobby body. Good legs and feet. Sound happy mover. 3. Cox's, Ashenberry All Socks at Suvern.
- MPB. (16). 1. Platts', Charbonnel Castanette. BPB. 8 months old black. Feminine head, melting expression. Pleasing outline. Good legs and feet. Sound free mover. Should have a bright future. 2. Fox's, Castanea Buttons n Bows. 8 months old b/r. Well proportioned. Happy sound mover. Good outline. Not as mature as winner. 3. Brooke's, Fonesse Freja at Kyrenia. PB. (13). 1. Wyeth's, Fendrove Solitaire. Quality black with pleasing head and eye. Compact well ribbed body. Good outline. Sound merry movement. 2. Marris-Bray's, H Dazzlyn 3. Reader's, Kaniboo Sheeza Dreamer.
- JB. (15). 1. Webster's, Asquanne Ginnelle JW. Well proportioned black with sweet head and expression. Good neck and shoulders. Tight feet. Moved with drive. 2. Whiteley's, Totenkopf Maybellene at Snowgate. Close up to winner. Promising youngster of pleasing proportions. Compact with good movement. Shown in excellent trim and condition. 3. Parker's, Lujesa Daniella at Weyhill.
- YB. (9). 1. Parkinson and Dillon's, Sh Ch. Dillonpark Ambrogina JW. Black with very pretty head. Fine neck running into excellent shoulders. Best of legs, tight feet. Sound merry mover, As always from this exhibitor A1 presentation. RCC. 2. Nugent's, Nulea Royal Temptress.

Compact b/r with best of heads. Good legs and feet. Moved freely wagging her tail. 3. Kengyelics' Marada Glow of Elegance at Hebdene.

NB 1. Youngs Canyonn Classic Touch. Quality red with good head and eye. In full coat and expertly presented. Sound true mover. 2. Reed's, Delindere Miss Smarty Pants. Compact, well marked liver/r. Feminine head. Good reach of neck. Sound mover. 3. Platt's, Charbonnel Black Dove.

TYRO B (5). 1. Craig's, Alisma Amelie. Pretty dark blye so typical of type bred by this kennel. Pleasing head and eye. Good layback, cobby body. Sound mover. 2. Glenntree Miss Tantaliser at Chaysonnie. B/t in good coat and condition. Pretty head and eye. Short cobby body. Good mover. 3. Wade's, Roandale Just in Time.

UGB. (1). 1. Ellison's, Withiflor Shining. Quality black. Feminine head, soft expression. Good neck and shoulders. Best of legs and feet. Short below hock. Sound free mover. Lovely bitch. PGB. (8). 1. Marris-Bray's, Helenwood Blue Willow. Dark compact blue excelling in head and eye. Good body. Well sprung ribs. Well placed shoulders. Free mover. 2. Burnet's, Moonshine Nighttime Solace at Charmwen JW. Well marked b/w. Feminine balanced head. Good body, well bent stifles and merry mover. 3. Reed's, Delindere She's a Moody Blue.

SpBEGIN B. (7). Close between first and second. Just preferred outline of winner. 1. Flynn's, Zarrepiott Shady Lady. Feminine dark b/r with pretty head and short well ribbed body. Good bend of stifle. Well presented and a positive mover. 2. Donnellan's, Gardenstone Starlight JW. Well marked b/w ticked. Pleasing head and good expression. Short backed and cobby. Good mover. 3. Reed's, Claramand Thriller Queen for Delindere.

LB. (15). 1. Marris-Bray's, Helenwood Wiggle Dance. Cockery red with such a pretty head. Excellent neck and shoulders. Good spring of rib. Stylish free mover. 2. Wyeth's, Fendrove Joy Rider. Well made b/t of depth. Moving very soundly. Good neck, shoulders and ribcage. Not as compact as winner. 3. Spencer's, Castanea Sweet Surrender to Terriles.

OB. (9). 1. Bentley's, Sh Ch. Canigou Classic Rock. CC, BOB and BIS. This stylish black has such a sweet head and soft expression. Good neck leading into fine well laid shoulders. Compact well ribbed body. Correct stylish moment. More particularly she has great ring presence. Beautifully presented. 2. Hackett's, Lindridge Ginger Rogers. Merry and sound moving orange/white. Pleasing head and dark eye. Compact body. Merry mover. 3. Shapland's Deracor Doyenne.
