DOGS - Parti - Sp P (4,1a) 1 Masters' Manchela Paco Rabanne, attractive bl/r/t with a good head & expression, good neck let into well laid shoulders, short body with good quarters, sound happy mover, keeping a good topline on the move, beautifully presented; 2 Cassidy's Manchela Hugo Boss, attractive bl/r with a pleasant head, short body, good legs & feet, happy sound mover, well presented; 3 Beston's Ridgeackhs Snowman. Sp N (6,2) 1 Hackett's Lindridge Diamond Geeza, quality young dog of the calibre one expects from this kennel. Good head & eye, good neck & shoulders, short deep body with good ribs, powerful quarters, good legs & feet, sound & happy on the move, well presented, I shall watch his progress with interest; 2 M Hugo Boss; 3 Murray's Srathturret Time Will Tell. Sp G (4) 1 Mitchell's Glowhill Cotton Eyed Joe, high quality young dog who is difficult to fault. Pleasing head & expression, good neck let into well laid shoulders, good body with excellent ribs, short & compact, well boned legs & feet, moved with drive, beautifully presented, I liked him a lot; 2 Marris-Bray's Plaiglen Cool Dude at Helenwood, dark blue of good overall type, good head & expression, good letgs & feet, moved well; 3 Murray's Strathturret Raindance. Sp O (4) 1 Sh Ch Veratey Vincenzo at Cassom, where does one begin. Many judges far more eloquent than me have waxed lyrical about this superb young dog. Suffice to say that he is short & compact, good neck & shoulders with well sprung ribs, the best of legs & small neat feet, powerful quarters which he really used on the move, very free sound action maintaining a good topline on the move, in firm hard condition, put down to the minute & expertly handled. CC, BIS; 2 Mitchell's Sh Ch Glowhill Silver Spur, top quality dog, unlucky to meet 1 in such cracking form. Possibly the best headed dog at the show with a kind expression, good neck & shoulders, short body with good ribs, well boned legs & feet, sound happy mover, beautifully presented; 3 Morris' Syrmor Black & White Magic. Red/golden - Sp G (3) 1 Gilmour's Chavez Royal Dedication, attractive golden youngster with a good head & eye, short body, good ribs, excellent legs & feet, sound & happy on the move, beautifully presented; 2 Robinson's Jozelah Marinho, young golden dog with all the essentials. Short & compact with well laid shoulders, good legs & feet, good quarters, moved very well; 3 Marris-Bray's Weirdene Wizardry at Helenwood. Sp O (3) 1 Young's Sh Ch Canyonnn Classic Illusion, I have long admired this attractive golden dog & on handling him he did not disappoint. Excellent neck let into well laid shoulders, short deep compact body with well sprung ribs, well boned legs & feet, excellent quarters which drove him round the ring with his customary swagger, very sound & free moving, beautifully presented & expertly handled. RCC; 2 Ellison's Sh Ch Withiflor Rolling Stone, I have never seen this attractive golden dog look better. Good head & eye, good neck & well laid shoulders, short compact body, good legs & feet, beautifully presented, sound & happy on the move; 3 Holmes' Kenan Kumonn. B/b/t - Sp P (2) 1 Thomas' Snowgate Black Shadow among Claramand, promising young black with pleasant head & eye, short body with good ribs, well boned legs & feet, moved very well;

2 Hall's Oakrosa Leon, promising black youngster with all the essentials. Nice head & eye, short body, good legs & feet, moved soundly, well presented. Sp G (4) 1 Mason & Robertson's Lynshow Kuckoo with Zheridons, attractive black dog with short compact body, good neck & shoulders, legs & feet, good quarters, won this class on his sound happy movement; 2 Kews' Time Traveller by Wyleview, well constructed black with a pleasing head & expression, short well ribbed body, good legs & feet, moved nicely, well presented; 3 Boulton's Christiol Harveys Shadow. Sp O (4,1) 1 Costellos' Judika Arizona, well known b/t boy produced in hard condition, good head, short deep body with well sprung ribs & good quarters, sound happy mover maintaining a good topline on the move, very well presented; 2 Marris-Bray's Weirdene Wake Up at Helenwood, beautifully headed black dog, short & compact with good hindquarters, good legs & feet, moved well; 3 Hillary's Sheigra Mr Snuggles at Edaisy. V (5,2) 1 Sh Ch Sharemead Golden Syrup, this dog may be 7 years old but he still acts like a juvenile delinquent. Short & compact in good coat & condition, sound & exuberant mover. BV; 2 Reid's Sh Ch Shanaz Sporran, well known high quality bl/r dog who looked well on the day. Good head & eye, well laid shoulders, good quarters, moved well; 3 West's Sheigra Starstruck. MP (6,1) 1 Gains' Molkara Pharrell, I was very taken with this attractive golden youngster. Good head & expression with a kind eye, good neck & shoulders, well sprung ribs, good legs, neat feet, sound merry mover, well presented, should have a bright future. BMP; 2 Warrington's Zakova Goldsmith, another golden of similar type to 1 & much the same comments apply. Well constructed with good neck & shoulders, good quarters, good legs & feet, sound happy mover; 3 Nugent's Nulea Blue Moon. P (8) 1 M Paco Rabanne; 2 Cox's Gardenstone Pale Rider to Suvern, impressive light blue with good head & eye, good neck & well laid shoulders, short compact body with good rib, well muscled hindquarters, sound happy mover. Beautifully presented, close decision between 1 & 2; 3 Anslow's Olibond Jitterbug for Shansart. J (8,1) 1 Masters' Manchela Tiger Tim, superb young b/t ticked dog who has just gained his title. Excellent head with a tight kind eye, excellent neck & shoulders, well boned legs with neat feet, short compact body with good ribs, powerful quarters which he really used on the move, balanced throughout with no exaggerations, put down to the minute, sound merry mover; 2 Grices' Kyna Albert Tatlock, quality dark blue dog, unfortunate to meet 1 in such sparkling form. Good head & eye, good reach of neck with short back, well muscled hindquarters, sound happy mover, maintaining a good topline, excellent presentation; 3 Todd & Rahman's Lynwater Classic Design. Y (4,1) 1 Craigs' Alisma Zacharius, good quality blue with pleasing head & eye, short body with good ribs, well muscled hindquarters, sound & happy on the move; 2 Cowles' Shenjela Midnight Flyer, another typy blue, he is balanced throughout with good substance, presented in good condition, moved well; 3 Neatham's Shoogsea Peach Streisand. N (3) 1 Gilmour's Chavez Royal Performance, attractive young black dog of the quality one expects from this kennel. He has a pleasing head & expression with a kind eye, short well ribbed body, good legs & feet, beautifully presented, sound happy mover; 2 M Hugo Boss; 3 Murray's Strathturret Time Will Tell. UG (4,1) 1 Holmes' Kenan Kontyrole, smart young black dog of good quality, short & compact with good head & eye, good body, legs & feet, moved well maintaining a good topline, well presented; 2 Carey's Falconcers Democrat Of Ware, or/w of good overall quality. Good head & eye, short body, good legs & feet, moved well; 3 S Time Will Tell. PG (8,2) 1 Bunting's Allerts Knock Out at Mossdew, I was very impressed with this b/w ticked dog. Beautiful head with a tight kind eye. Excellent neck & shoulders, short deep compact body, the best of legs & feet, good quarters. Beautifully presented, sound & happy on the move maintaining a good topline; 2 Thomas' Abercrombie Of La View Magnafique for Claramand, a blue dog I have watched since he was a puppy & is now turning into a very nice dog. Lovely head & eye, good neck & shoulders, short compact

body, good legs & feet, very sound on the move. Not the biggest of dogs but full of quality; 3 Brookes' Kyrenia Myosotis Memories. **B** (6,1) 1 Cartney's Carlundies Cooper, very typy blue of good conformation. Good head & expression, short compact body, good legs & feet, sound happy mover; 2 M Hugo Boss; 3 S Mr Snuggles at E. L (13,2) 1 Gilmour's Chavez Royal Dreamer, high quality black so typical of this kennel. Excellent neck let into well laid shoulders, short compact body with excellent ribs, good legs & neat feet, sound & happy on the move with a good topline, as with all exhibits from this kennel, presentation was first class; 2 Brookes' Kyrenia Mirror Image, pale golden dog presented in first rate condition. Pleasant head & eye, good neck & shoulders, short with excellent rib, well put down, moved soundly & with great drive; 3 West's Sheigra Stargazer. **O** (6) 1 Share-Jones' Sharemead The Sultan, beautifully headed golden dog with a kind expression, short compact body, well muscled hindquarters, good legs with short hocks, sound happy mover, well presented; 2 J Marinho; 3 Time Traveller by W.
