BIS was Marris-Bray's Sh Ch Helenwood Irresistabelle, Res BIS Young's Canyonn Classic Touch, BOS Share-Jones' Sharemead Golden Syrup and BP Gilmour's Chavez Royal Allegiance.

Red / Golden / Liver / Liver & Tan Sp P (6,2) 1 Brookes' Kyrenia Paint A Picture. 10 month old red dog, scored in neck and shoulders. Short deep body, good ribs and quarters and nicely presented. Moved well. 2 Lester's Quettadene Rose Gold. 3 Marris-Bray's Helenwood Grin and Bear It.

- Sp J (2,1) 1 Thomas' King of Clowns vom Odenwald. 12 month liver and tan dog of good overall type. Good head, neck and shoulders, good body and excellent bone. Sound mover.
- SpG (5,2) 1 Reed's Delindere Wanna B the One. Well made red dog with a good head and eye, short well ribbed body. Good quarters and nicely presented. Went well. 2 Corcoran's Troverothway Bobby Sox. 3 Mason's Kerriglow Ruby Slippers to Sandlauga.
- SpO (8,1) The class of the day was won by Share-Jones' Sharemead Golden Syrup. Excellent young dog I have often admired from the ringside and I was not disappointed when handling him. Pleasant head with a good eye, well laid shoulders and a short, deep and well ribbed body. Excellent bone, sound and exuberant mover. He should do well. BOS. 2 Siviter's Lochranza Specially Made for Trentshome. 3 Brooks' Lochdene Bravado at Kyrenia.
- Black or Black & Tan Sp P (8,1) 1 Webster's Asquanne Guillamon. Promising black baby with a good head and expression. Well laid shoulders, good ribs and excellent bone. Sound and happy mover, should have a bright future. Best MP. 2 Costello's Claramand Quickstep to Judika. 3 Thomas'Afterlife Angel in Disguise at Claramand.
- SpJ (5,2) 1 Siviter's Trentshome Sno Business. This high quality black bitch is maturing nicely. Pleasing head and expression with a good eye, good neck flowing into well laid shoulders, short body with good ribs and strong quarters. Well turned stifle, sound and happy on the move and beautifully presented. Came close to top honours. 2 Rowland's Perrytree Midnight Sky. 3 Hickman's Freestone Fundamentalist.
- SpG (8,2) 1 Gilmour's Chavez Royal Passion. Black bitch with a good head and expression. Good neck and shoulders, short and compact with good quarters. Beautifully presented, as were all exhibits from this kennel. Moved well. 2 Shapland's Deracor Deejay. 3 Hutchings' Asquanne Go Likely at Beechtops.
- SpO (4,1) 1 Marris-Bray's Helenwood Dazzlyn. Top quality exhibit and so typical of this kennel. Scored well in head, neck and shoulders. Short and compact with good muscle tone, excellent legs and feet, nicely presented and moved well. 2 Rose's Cascadia China White a Benira. 3 Turner's Jalankiu Black Lace.
- SpMPD (5) 1 Webster's A Guillamon. 2 Costello's Judika New Moon. 3 Barnes' Debcot Right Connection. SpMPB (4) 1 Lester's Quettadene Rose Gold. Very appealing golden baby with a sweet head and expression. Good body, legs and front. Should have a bright future. 2 Barnes' Debcot You Got It. 3 Gillespie and Wilding's Lochranza Spanish Eyes.
- SpPD (6,1) 1 Webster's A Guillamon. 2 Thomas' Afterlife Encounter by Claramand. 3 Clinton's Oramiss Foreign Affair. SpPB (7,2) 1 Gilmour's Chavez Royal Allegiance. Superb black bitch in beautiful coat and condition. Gorgeous head with tight eyes. Good neck, let into well laid shoulders, short and compact and the best of legs and feet. Sound and happy mover, beautifully presented. BPIS. 2 Marris-Bray's Helenwood Red Willow. 3 Costollo's C Ostep to J.
- SpJ (2) 1 Rowland's Perrytree Midnight Sky. Young black dog of overall good type, who is maturing nicely. Sweet expression, short body with well sprung ribs and well muscled quarters. Nicely presented and moved well. 2 Oliver's Swanmarch First Overture for Olivesong. AC SpN (5,3) 1 K of C v O'wald. 2 Hickman's Freestone Fundamentalist.
- SpG (8,1) 1 Parkinson and Dillon's Dillonpark Florengina. Impressive young black bitch and an object lesson in presentation. Pleasing head with a good eye, good neck let into well laid shoulders, excellent ribs and good quarters. Well turned stifle, short hocks and moved well keeping a good topline on the move. 2 Gilmour's Chavez Intrigue. 3 Marsh's Quintavia Sugar Plum at Sayajirao.
- SpPG (6) 1 Young's Canyonn Classic Touch. I really feel for this delightful golden bitch. Very feminine with nothing flashy about her. but a sound and honest Cocker. Balanced throughout

with a sweet head and expression. Short and compact with good legs and neat feet. Beautifully presented and well handled, never put a foot wrong. Res BIS. 2 Brookes' Kyrenia Myosotis Mark. 3 West's Sheigra Starstruck.

Sp Beginners (10) 1 Herd's Quintavia Rock N Rose. Black bitch of good type and construction. Good head, short deep body and good legs and feet. Strong quarters, nicely presented and moved well. 2 Simmond's Lujesa Dolce Fiore for Keladity. 3 Reed's Claramand Thriller Queen for Delindre.

SpOD (2,1) 1 Young's Canyonn Classic Welcome. Good quality dog as one would expect from this kennel. Good head, well laid shoulders and a short deep body with good spring of rib. Powerful quarters, nicely presented and a sound and happy mover.

SpOB (4,1) 1 West's Sheigra Sixties Song. 6 years old black and tan bitch who is wearing well. Nice head with a pleasant expression. Short deep body and good bone, sound enthusiastic mover. 2 Marsh's Quintavia Phoebe at Sayajiaro. 3 Turner's Jalankia Black Lace.

Vet (4,2) 1 Marris-Bray's Sh Ch Helenswood Irresistable. Outstanding black bitch, it defies belief that she is 9 and a half years old, she could easily pass for 3, and great credit must go to her owners for presenting her in such fantastic condition. Sweet head and expression, excellent neck flowing into well laid shoulders, short and compact body with well sprung ribs. The best of legs and feet, well muscled hindquarters and sound as a bell. Beautifully presented and expertly handled. I had no hesitation in awarding her BIS. 2 Mason's Berry Rose at Sandlauga.
